DISCUSSION: The Director of the Texas Service Center denied the immigrant visa petition. A subsequent appeal was summarily dismissed by the Associate Commissioner for Examinations on May 7, 2001. On June 5, 2001, counsel, in behalf of the petitioner, filed a motion to reopen and reconsider. On March 26, 2002, counsel informed the Associate Commissioner that the petitioner wished to withdraw its motion to reopen and reconsider filed on June 5, 2001.
