DISCUSSION: The employment-based immigrant visa petition was denied by the Director, Nebraska Service Center, and is now before the Administrative Appeals Office on appeal. On May 13, 2004, counsel submitted a letter to Citizenship and Immigration Services (CIS), withdrawing the appeal relating to LIN 02 253 52942.
