



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



DISCUSSION: The Director, Nebraska Service Center, denied the nonimmigrant visa petition. The matter is before the Administrative Appeals Office on Appeal. On August 29, 2003, counsel, on behalf of the petitioner, filed a motion to reconsider along with an a Form I-290B appeal. By letter dated June 29, 2004, counsel informed the Administrative Appeals Office that the petitioner wished to withdraw the appeal and the motion to reconsider filed on August 29, 2003.
