



DISCUSSION: The Acting Director, Vermont Service Center, revoked approval of the third preference immigrant visa petition. The matter is before the Administrative Appeals Office on appeal. On December 12, 2007 this office received, by facsimile transmission, a letter from the petitioner's president dated July 19, 2007. The petitioner's president informed the Administrative Appeals Office that the petitioner wished to withdraw the appeal filed on January 4, 2006. The withdrawal may not be retracted. 8 C.F.R. § 103.2(b)(6).
