



DISCUSSION: The service center director denied the nonimmigrant visa petition. The matter is now on appeal before the Administrative Appeals Office (AAO). The appeal will be summarily dismissed. The petition will be denied.

The petitioner is a chain of retail stores. It seeks to employ the beneficiary as a sales data analyst and to continue his classification as a nonimmigrant worker in a specialty occupation pursuant to section 101(a)(15)(H)(i)(b) of the Immigration and Nationality Act, 8 U.S.C. § 1101(a)(15)(H)(i)(b).

The director denied the petition on the ground that the record failed to establish that the proffered position qualifies as a specialty occupation.

On appeal the petitioner states as follows: "Please reconsider your decision based on evidence provided at the time of original submission." On the appeal form the petitioner indicated that a separate brief or evidence would not be submitted. No further supporting documentation has been submitted in support of the appeal.

As specified in 8 C.F.R. § 103.3(a)(1)(v), "[a]n officer to whom an appeal is taken shall summarily dismiss any appeal when the party concerned fails to identify specifically any erroneous conclusion of law or statement of fact for the appeal." The petitioner has not specifically identified any erroneous conclusion of law or statement of fact in the decision. Accordingly, the appeal will be summarily dismissed.

ORDER: The appeal is dismissed. The petition is denied.
