





DISCUSSION: The nonimmigrant visa petition was denied by the Director, California Service Center, and the Administrative Appeals Office (AAO) dismissed a subsequent appeal. When the matter came before the AAO on motion to reconsider, the AAO affirmed its previous decision, on April 19, 2005. The AAO now reopens the proceedings, on its own motion; and it will withdraw its decision of April 19, 2005 and its previous decision of September 30, 2004 on the appeal of this petition. The AAO also will approve the petition for the period of time requested in the petition.

ORDER: The previous decisions of the AAO are withdrawn. The petition is approved.
