**DISCUSSION:** The application was denied by the District Director, San Francisco, California. The matter is now before the Administrative Appeals Office (AAO) on appeal. The appeal will be summarily dismissed.

The applicant is a native of Somalia and a naturalized citizen of the United States. She seeks to have her Certificate of Naturalization corrected under section 338 of the Immigration and Nationality Act (the Act), 8 U.S.C. § 1449, to reflect a change in her date of birth from January 1, 1941 to June 15, 1931.

The district director reviewed the applicant's record and determined that her request was not justifiable under 8 C.F.R. § 338.5. The application was denied accordingly.

The applicant asserts on appeal that she is not happy with the district director's decision. The applicant asserts that she has evidence of her real age, and she requests reconsideration of the district director's decision. The applicant makes no other assertions on appeal.

8 C.F.R. § 103.3(a)(v) states in pertinent part:

(v) Summary dismissal. An officer to whom an appeal is taken shall summarily dismiss any appeal when the party concerned fails to identify specifically any erroneous conclusion of law or statement of fact for the appeal.

The applicant in the present matter failed to identify any erroneous conclusion of law or statement of fact on appeal. Her appeal will therefore be summarily dismissed.

**ORDER:** The appeal is summarily dismissed.
