**DISCUSSION:** The waiver application was denied by the District Director, Los Angeles (Santa Ana), CA. The matter is now before the Administrative Appeals Office (AAO) on a motion to reconsider. The motion to reconsider was filed subsequent to the AAO's denial of the applicant's appeal. On June 9, 2006, the applicant's spouse, through counsel, requested that the underlying Form I-130, Petition for Alien Relative, be withdrawn. As the applicant's motion to reconsider requires an underlying petition, the motion will be dismissed.
