On February 19, 1991, the Director, Western Service Center, issued a Notice of Decision, which denied your Form I-700 Application for Temporary Resident Status as a Special Agricultural Worker. On March 20, 1991, you filed a timely appeal. On November 5, 2001, the Administrative Appeals Office (AAO) remanded your case for a new decision, which addressed the employment documentation in the record.

On November 24, 2004, the Director, California Service Center, withdrew the previous decision of February 19, 1991, reopened the proceedings, and issued a new Notice of Decision. In this notice, the director incorrectly advised you that your appeal from the initial Notice of Decision was still in effect. The record, however, reflects that on November 16, 2004, that appeal was terminated. Because the appeal had been terminated, there is no pending appeal before this office.

For these reason, your case is being returned to the California Service Center without any action from the AAO.
