On October 30, 1991, the Director, Western Service Center, issued a Notice of Decision, which denied your Form I-700 Application for Temporary Resident Status as a Special Agricultural Worker. On November 21, 1991, you filed a timely appeal. On September 16, 2005, the Administrative Appeals Office (AAO) sustained the appeal upon finding that you had performed the requisite qualifying agricultural employment during the twelve-month eligibility period ending May 1, 1986.

On the basis of a positive response from the Federal Bureau of Investigation, on August 30, 2006, a Notice of Intent to Deny was issued advising you to submit court dispositions for all arrests.

On October 23, 2006, the Director, California Service Center, denied your Form I-700 application because you failed to submit *all* the requested court dispositions.

The case was forwarded to the AAO for review. In this notice, the director incorrectly advised you that your appeal from the initial Notice of Decision was still in effect. Because the AAO had *sustained* that appeal on September 16, 2005, there is no pending appeal before this office.

For these reason, your case is being returned to the California Service Center without any action from the AAO.
