On August 3, 2001, you filed an application for status as a permanent resident pursuant to section 1104 of the Legal Immigration Family Equity (LIFE) Act of 2000, Pub. L. 106-553, 114 Stat. 2762 (2000), *amended by* LIFE Act Amendments, Pub. L. 106-554, 114 Stat. 2763 (2000).

Subsequently, on December 16, 2004, the District Director, Los Angeles, denied your application. You have appealed that decision, and your appeal is now before the Administrative Appeals Office (AAO).

The regulation at 8 C.F.R. § 103.2(b)(5) provides:

Request for an original document. Where a copy of a document is submitted with an application or petition, the Service may at any time require that the original document be submitted for review. If the requested original, other than one issued by the Service, is not submitted within 12 weeks, the petition or application shall be denied or revoked. There shall be no appeal from a denial or revocation based on the failure to submit an original document upon the request of the Service to substantiate a previously submitted copy. Further, an applicant or petitioner may not move to reopen or reconsider the proceeding based on the subsequent availability of the document. An original document submitted pursuant to a Service request shall be returned to the petitioner or applicant when no longer required.

Please submit the originals of the following documents:

1. All money order receipts submitted in support of the application.
2. All envelopes submitted in support of the application.
3. Season Player's Identification Card.

According to the regulation at 8 C.F.R. § 103.2(b)(5), you are hereby afforded 12 weeks in which to respond.
