Application for Status as a Permanent Resident pursuant to Section 1104 of the Legal Immigration Family Equity (LIFE) Act of 2000, Pub. L. 106-553, 114 Stat. 2762 (2000), amended by Life Act Amendments, Pub. L. 106-554, 114 Stat. 2763 (2000).

**DISCUSSION:** The application for permanent resident status under the Legal Immigration Family Equity (LIFE) Act was denied by the District Director, Chicago, Illinois. The matter is now before the Administrative Appeals Office. On September 3, 2004, counsel executed a letter in which he indicated that the applicant had passed away. As evidence, counsel provided a copy of the applicant's death certificate.

Accordingly, the appeal is dismissed. All documents have been returned to the office that originally decided the case. Any further inquiry must be made to that office.
