DISCUSSION: This matter is an application for adjustment from temporary to permanent resident status denied by the Director, Texas Service Center, which is before the Legalization Appeals Office (AAO) on appeal. The appeal will be rejected.

The director denied the application because the applicant's temporary resident status was terminated based on her failure to provide requested documentation.

An adverse decision on an application for temporary resident status may be appealed to the AAO. Any appeal with the required fee shall be filed with the Service Center within thirty (30) days after service of the notice of denial. An appeal received after the thirty-day period has tolled will not be accepted. *See* 8 C.F.R. § 245a.2(p).

The director issued the notice of denial on July 22, 1992 and mailed it to the applicant's address of record. The record contains a postal return receipt that was signed on July 24, 1992. The appeal was received on January 5, 2006. The appeal was untimely filed and, therefore, must be rejected.

ORDER: The appeal is rejected.
