DISCUSSION: The application for temporary resident status was denied by the Director, Western Service Center, and is now before the Administrative Appeals Office (AAO) on appeal. The appeal will be dismissed.

The record reflects that subsequent to the filing of a Notice of Appeal of Decision by the applicant, the case was remanded by the AAO, the case was reopened and the Form I-700 application was approved by the director. Therefore, the earlier appeal is moot.

ORDER: The appeal is dismissed.
