DISCUSSION: The application for temporary resident status as a special agricultural worker was denied by the Director, Western Service Center and reopened by the Director, Western Service Center. The matter is now before the Administrative Appeal Office (AAO) on appeal. The case will be remanded for further consideration and action.

The record does not contain any decision issued subsequent to the reopening of the proceedings on March 19, 1991. The director must issue a decision discussing the issues as presently constituted in the record. According to 8 C.F.R. 103.3(a)(3), whenever an application for special agricultural worker is denied, the alien shall be given written notice setting forth the specific reasons for the denial on Form I-692.

The case is remanded for the purpose of a written decision which fully addresses the evidence. Should the decision be adverse, the applicant shall be permitted to file an appeal, without fee.

ORDER: The case is remanded for appropriate action and decision consistent with the foregoing.
