**DISCUSSION:** The application was denied by the Director, Texas Service Center, and is now before the Administrative Appeals Office on appeal. The appeal will be rejected.

The applicant is a native and citizen of Honduras who is seeking Temporary Protected Status (TPS) under section 244 of the Immigration and Nationality Act (the Act), 8 U.S.C. § 1254.

The director determined that the applicant failed to establish that he was eligible for filing his TPS application after the initial registration period from January 5, 1999 to August 20, 1999. The applicant filed his initial application on July 3, 2002. The director, therefore, denied the application.

"Affected Party," means the person or entity with legal standing in a proceeding. 8 C.F.R. § 103.3(a)(1)(iii)(B).

An appeal filed by a person or entity not entitled to file it must be rejected as improperly filed. In such a case, any filing fee, which has been accepted, will not be refunded. 8 C.F.R. § 103.3(a)(2)(v).

In this case, the appeal was filed by [REDACTED] of Hispanic Coalition, who indicates that her organization is an accredited representative recognized by the Board of Immigration Appeals. However, the U.S. Department of Justice, Executive Office for Immigration Review, Recognition and Accreditation Roster does not list either [REDACTED] or Hispanic Coalition as recognized entities. Therefore, the appeal will be rejected.

**ORDER:** The appeal is rejected.
