**DISCUSSION:** The application was denied by the Director, Vermont Service Center, and is now before the Administrative Appeals Office on appeal. The appeal will be dismissed.

The applicant is a native and citizen of Honduras who is seeking Temporary Protected Status (TPS) under section 244 of the Immigration and Nationality Act (the Act), 8 U.S.C. § 1254.

The director determined that the applicant failed to submit evidence to establish that she was eligible for filing for TPS after the initial registration period from January 5, 1999 to August 20, 1999. On February 10, 2003, the director denied the application.

On appeal, the applicant fails to address the grounds of denial or submit evidence of eligibility for late registration. The applicant states that she would submit a brief or additional evidence within 30 days from March 4, 2003. To date, however, no brief or additional evidence has been received. Therefore, the record will be considered complete.

8 C.F.R. § 103.3(a)(1)(v) states, in pertinent part:

Summary dismissal. An officer to whom an appeal is taken shall summarily dismiss any appeal when the party concerned fails to identify specifically any erroneous conclusion of law or statement of fact for the appeal.

The applicant has failed to identify specifically any erroneous conclusion of law or statement of fact for the appeal. Nor did the applicant address the issue of eligibility for late registration. Accordingly, the appeal will be summarily dismissed.

**ORDER:** The appeal is summarily dismissed.
