DISCUSSION: The Temporary Protection Status application was denied by the Director, Texas Service Center. A motion to reopen, filed by the applicant on January 6, 2004, was granted by the director, allowing the applicant 30 days to submit additional evidence.

The director initially had denied the application filed on June 20, 2003 because the applicant failed to establish that he was eligible for filing his TPS application after the initial registration period from January 5, 1999 to August 20, 1999. The record does not contain a decision subsequent to the reopening of the case on February 23, 2004.

A subsequent motion to reopen was filed on March 8, 2004.

The case is remanded to the director for the purpose of issuance of a decision on the currently open motion pending before the Bureau of Citizenship and Immigration Services.

ORDER: The case is remanded for appropriate action and decision consistent with the foregoing.
