



**DISCUSSION:** The Director, Vermont Service Center (VSC), denied the application. The application is now before the Administrative Appeals Office (AAO) on appeal. The case will be remanded for further action.

The applicant is a native and citizen of Nicaragua who was granted Employment Authorization under 8 C.F.R. § 274a.12(c)(19) as an alien with a pending application for Temporary Protected Status (TPS).

On August 27, 2007, the director denied the current application for Employment Authorization because the underlying TPS application had been denied. In response to the director's decision, the applicant filed a Form I-290B, Notice of Appeal or Motion. The Director, Vermont Service Center denied that motion on May 27, 2008. The applicant subsequently filed an appeal of that decision to the AAO.

The AAO has no jurisdiction over applications for Employment Authorization. The director erroneously accepted the applicant's response and forwarded the file to the AAO. Therefore, the case will be remanded and the director shall consider the applicant's response as another motion to reopen.

As always in these proceedings, the burden of proof rests solely with the applicant. Section 291 of the Act, 8 U.S.C. § 1361.

**ORDER:** The case is remanded to the director for further action consistent with the above and entry of a decision.
