Temporary Protected Status (TPS) for Honduras, Syria and Nepal

We have updated information regarding the following TPS and TPS-based Employment Authorization Documents (EADs):

- TPS for Honduras will terminate Jan. 5, 2020. EADs are automatically extended through Jan. 1, 2019.
- TPS for Syria is designated through Sept. 30, 2019. EADs are automatically extended through Sept. 27, 2018.
- TPS for Nepal will terminate June 24, 2019. EADs are automatically extended through Dec. 21, 2018.
