How to Become an Authorized Immigration Service Provider...

Who is an authorized immigration service provider?

According to federal law, there are two groups of individuals that are authorized to represent applicants before USCIS.

- A representative accredited by the Board of Immigration Appeals working for a recognized organization, and
- An attorney who is in good standing.

As an authorized immigration service provider you can:

- Select what form an applicant should submit,
- Provide legal advice about documents to submit,
- Explain immigration options, and
- Communicate with USCIS about an applicant's case.

If I am not an authorized immigration service provider, what can I do?

You can **only**:

- Read the form to the individual.
- Translate, either verbally or in writing, information from the individual's native language to English or English to the individual's language.
- Write down information that the individual provides to complete the application.

How do I or my organization become an authorized immigration service provider?

An organization or individual must become recognized or accredited through the Department of Justice Board of Immigration Appeals (BIA). To learn more about the application process, please visit
