## **USCIS to Welcome 92 New Citizens During Fourth of July Celebration at The President Benjamin Harrison Home**

INDIANAPOLIS, Ind. — U.S. Citizenship and Immigration Services (USCIS) will conduct a special naturalization ceremony celebrating the Fourth of July this Friday, July 2. This year's ceremony, which will be held at the President Benjamin Harrison Home, will celebrate our nation's 234th birthday under the theme, "A Spirit of Independence."

U.S. District Court Judge Sara Evans Barker will administer the *Oath of Allegiance* to the 92 new citizens who represent 42 countries. A new citizen will address the crowd speaking about her journey to America.

This ceremony is part of USCIS's annual celebration of Independence Day. An estimated 3,800 candidates will become citizens at 55 special ceremonies held across the country and around the world from July 1-6.
