The USCIS Office of Public Engagement invites you to a teleconference to discuss the USCIS External Data Interface Standard (EDIS). EDIS is a set of technical standards that enable a third party immigration practitioner's system to securely transfer digital immigration benefit request data directly to USCIS. This system-to-system interface will be a new electronic filing (E-filing) channel, and is intended to increase efficiency and improve the acceptance rate for immigration benefit requests. EDIS is part of the Agency's broader USCIS Transformation Program effort to create a more transparent, efficient and customer focused organization.
