USCIS Office of Public Engagement would like to invite you to a teleconference regarding the evidentiary standards of the “O” nonimmigrant classification on Thursday, April 28th at 2 PM (EDT).

Specifically, USCIS is seeking stakeholder feedback on the evaluation of evidence submitted with Form I-129, Petition for Nonimmigrant Worker, when filed on behalf of O-1 nonimmigrants and the adjudicatory standards for these petitions within the current regulatory framework. USCIS is taking this opportunity to hear from stakeholders on this key issue in order to obtain valuable input for consideration in drafting a policy memorandum on evidentiary standards. The purpose of a draft policy memorandum is to provide additional guidance to ensure consistency in adjudication of petitions filed under the O-1 classification and to clarify the adjudication standards for these petitions.

We greatly look forward to your suggestions and feedback on the contents of a draft memo addressing “O” evidentiary standards within the current regulatory framework.
