Form I-130 Process Changes for Petitioners Residing Overseas

The USCIS International Operations Division, Office of Policy & Strategy, and Office of Public Engagement invite you to participate in a teleconference to discuss process changes for the Form I-130, Petition for Alien Relative filed by petitioners residing overseas.

Effective August 15, 2011, petitioners residing in countries without USCIS offices generally will be required to file Form I-130 with the USCIS Chicago Lockbox. Petitioners residing in a country with a USCIS office have the option of sending their I-130 forms to the Chicago Lockbox or continue to file their Forms I-130 at the international USCIS office having jurisdiction over the area where they live.

During this session, USCIS will provide an overview of how these process changes may affect filing and adjudication as well as address questions and concerns from stakeholders.
