Defining Temporary Need in the H-2B Context

U.S. Citizenship and Immigration Services (USCIS) invites interested individuals to participate in a stakeholder engagement on **Wednesday, May 2, 2012 from 2:00pm to 3:30pm (Eastern)**.

USCIS is reviewing its policies related to the H-2B non-agricultural temporary worker program, particularly the definition of temporary work in the H-2B context. Under the H-2B program, a petitioner must demonstrate a temporary need for workers. In determining whether a petitioner has met this requirement, USCIS considers the duration, type and location of work to be performed, as well as whether the employer or its proxy seeks H-2B workers to perform similar duties in multiple locations.

During this engagement USCIS subject matter experts will discuss stakeholder feedback on H-2B legal and policy issues and answer questions.
