On May 22, 2012, USCIS launched the first phase of our electronic immigration system, known as USCIS ELIS. This agency-wide initiative brings USCIS closer to realizing the Web-based future of immigration services and is part of USCIS's continuous effort to better serve our customers.

USCIS will gradually expand USCIS ELIS to cover most immigration benefits and will add new form types and functionality on a regular basis.
