U.S. Citizenship and Immigration Services (USCIS) invites you to participate in a stakeholder webinar on **Wednesday, July 30, 2014, from 3:30-4:30 p.m. (Eastern)** to learn more about the new USCIS Electronic Immigration System (USCIS ELIS) Form I-526, Immigrant Petition by Alien Entrepreneur, and the document library functionality.

The USCIS ELIS Form I-526 allows customers to submit their petition electronically, upload evidence, and track case status in real-time. The USCIS ELIS Document Library allows regional centers to provide immigrant investors in new commercial enterprises with electronic copies of documents regarding their investments, including organizational, transactional, and offering documents. Form I-526 petitioners can access electronic copies of documents pertaining to their investment, attest the documents are true and accurate copies, and supplement their electronic or paper-based Form I-526 petition with documents stored in the document library.

During this webinar, USCIS will demonstrate this functionality and provide tips on using USCIS ELIS features.
