What is SAVE?

The Systematic Alien Verification for Entitlements (SAVE) Program is an information service for authorized agencies to verify their applicants' immigration status. Registered agencies use SAVE to determine applicants' eligibility for benefits they administer. SAVE is administered by U.S. Citizenship and Immigration Services, a component of the Department of Homeland Security.

What SAVE Verifies

- Nonimmigrant status
- Immigrant status
- U.S. citizenship of naturalized and derived citizens

Why SAVE

- Fast, secure, and reliable information service
- More than 90% of SAVE cases are completed in just seconds
- SAVE has access to more than 100 million federal records
- SAVE has over 80% customer satisfaction rate

Help Your Applicants with CaseCheck

While applicants wait for results, they can track their cases with the free online CaseCheck service. Applicants may use this instead of visiting or calling your agency to ask about the status of their case. This saves everyone time.

Who Can Use SAVE?

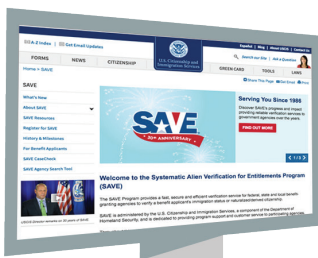
Registered federal, state, or local government agencies and licensing bureaus with a legal authority to use SAVE.

How to Register an Agency

- Visit uscis.gov/save and click "Register for SAVE"
- The SAVE team will help you understand the terms and conditions before you enter into an agreement with SAVE
