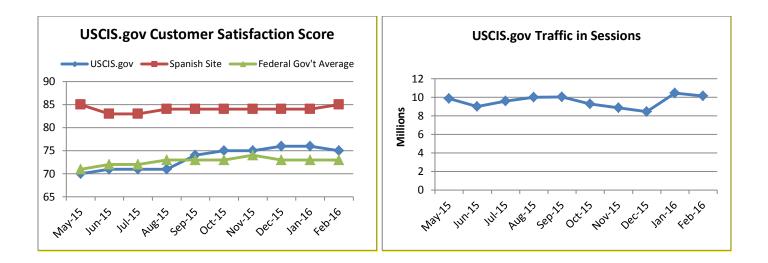

Highlights:

- **Traffic Stable:** Overall, traffic to the website dipped modestly relative to January, but this was primarily due to the shorter month (29 vs. 31 days), with no dramatic spikes in any major area.
- The Citizenship and Test Interview Video Shines on Facebook:
 - <u>Our top Facebook item</u> in February by a sizeable margin was the posting of our Citizenship and Naturalization Interview Video, which had a reach of over 800,000. By comparison, the number two post reached 138,000.
 - Not surprisingly, the same video remained on top <u>on our YouTube channel</u>, gathering nearly 25,000 more views in February for a lifetime total of over 1.67 million views.
- NBA Naturalization Ceremony in Phoenix Scores on Twitter: Three of our top five tweets this month featured a February 19 naturalization ceremony held during halftime at a Phoenix Suns basketball game, producing well over 40,000 impressions.
