The petitioner submitted a letter, dated July 15, 2014, requesting that the Form I-129 (Petition for a Nonimmigrant Worker) be withdrawn. As the request to withdraw the original petition was received before the issuance of our decision in this matter, the issues in this proceeding are now moot, and the appeal will be dismissed on this basis.
