

**DISCUSSION:** The nonimmigrant visa petition was approved by the Director, Vermont Service Center, and certified to the Administrative Appeals Office (AAO) for review as required by 8 C.F.R. § 214.2(h)(9)(iii)(B)(2)(ii). The decision of the director will be affirmed and the petition will be approved.

The petitioner operates a seasonal landscaping business located on Cape Cod in the town of Eastham. It desires to employ the beneficiaries as landscape laborers for a period of five and one-half months. The Department of Labor (DOL) determined that a temporary certification by the Secretary of Labor could not be made.

The director determined that sufficient countervailing evidence has been submitted to show that qualified persons in the United States are not available, that the employment policies of the DOL have been observed and that the need for the services to be performed is temporary.

After review of the evidence contained in the record, the decision of the director is found to be correct. The petitioner has provided sufficient evidence to establish that the need for the beneficiaries' services is peakload and temporary. The Vermont Service Center will issue the appropriate approval notice.

**ORDER:** The decision of the director is affirmed. The nonimmigrant visa petition is approved.
