

DISCUSSION: The waiver application was denied by the District Director, St. Paul, Minnesota. The matter is now before the Administrative Appeals Office on appeal. On September 30, 2005, counsel requested that Citizenship and Immigration Services stop processing on the applicant's adjustment of status application. Based on this request by counsel, the appeal of the denial of the I-601 waiver application is dismissed as the underlying application is no longer being processed.
