



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

**DISCUSSION:** The director denied the application for temporary resident status pursuant to the terms of the settlement agreements reached in *Catholic Social Services, Inc., et al., v. Ridge, et al.*, CIV. NO. S-86-1343-LKK (E.D. Cal) January 23, 2004, and *Felicity Mary Newman, et al., v. United States Immigration and Citizenship Services, et al.*, CIV. NO. 87-4757-WDK (C.D. Cal) February 17, 2004, and the matter is now before the Administrative Appeals Office (AAO) on appeal. On February 13, 2009, counsel submitted a letter on the applicant's behalf requesting that the applicant's Form I-687, Application for Status as a Temporary Resident, and corresponding appeal be withdrawn.

**ORDER:** The appeal is dismissed based upon the withdrawal of the application.
