

DISCUSSION: The application was denied by the Acting Director, Nebraska Service Center, and is now before the Administrative Appeals Office (AAO) on appeal. The appeal will be dismissed.

The applicant is a native and citizen of Laos, who seeks to obtain a travel document (reentry permit) under section 223 of the Immigration and Nationality Act (the Act), 8 U.S.C. § 1203. The Acting Director denied the application as a matter of discretion after determining that the applicant has adverse information in his record. *See Acting Director's Decision* dated June 21, 2006.

On appeal, the applicant submits a new Form I-131 and states that the previously submitted Form I-131 was prepared incorrectly. *Form I-290B*, undated. No evidence or information was submitted, and the appeal does not dispute or otherwise address the grounds upon which the applicant's application for a travel document was denied.

8 C.F.R. § 103.3(a)(v) states in pertinent part that:

(v) Summary dismissal. An officer to whom an appeal is taken shall summarily dismiss any appeal when the party concerned fails to identify specifically any erroneous conclusion of law or statement of fact for the appeal.

The AAO finds that the applicant's appeal fails to identify any erroneous conclusion of law or statement of fact in the director's decision. The appeal is therefore summarily dismissed.

ORDER: The appeal is dismissed.
