The director denied the application for Status as a Permanent Resident pursuant to Section 1104 of the Legal Immigration Family Equity (LIFE) Act of 2000, Pub. L. 106-553, 114 Stat. 2762 (2000), *amended* by Life Act Amendments, Pub. L. 106-554, 114 Stat. 2763 (2000), and the matter is now before the Administrative Appeals Office (AAO) on appeal.
