[myE-Verify](#) is a website from the U.S Department of Homeland Security designed for U.S. workers and jobseekers. myE-Verify is available in English and Spanish.

- myE-Verify users can verify their own employment authorization, protect their identity, track their E-Verify case, learn about their rights, and understand employer responsibilities.

Find these features on myE-Verify:

- [Self Check](#) lets individuals residing in the United States aged 16 and over confirm their own work authorization in [E-Verify](#).
- [Case Tracker](#) lets employees follow the status of their own E-Verify case resolution.
- [myE-Verify accounts](#) are secure personal accounts that give access to features that help protect your social security number and prevent identity theft:
 - o To establish the secure account, you must pass an identity proofing quiz and receive an employment authorized result from your Self Check query.
 - o Account holders can use the [Self Lock](#) feature to protect their social security number from being misused in E-Verify. This helps prevent identity theft.
 - o [Case History](#) can be used by myE-Verify account holders to view where and when their information has been used in E-Verify.
